Abstract Submission

- Abstracts will be selected for either Oral or Poster presentation • Authors will receive a confirmation before 15th Oct 2022 • Word limit - 300 words

Presentation Types:

- Authors may submit 1 or more abstracts for consideration for presentation at the meeting. All abstracts will be reviewed by the abstract review committee. The selected abstracts will be short-listed for either oral or poster presentation. Date & time of the presentation will be intimated later. Each oral presenter will be given 8 minutes for presentation, followed by 2 minutes for questions.

Your Abstract should adhere to the following Format:

- TITLE: Your title should be as concise and accurate as possible.
- AUTHOR: Name of all authors

- **AIM** : State in 1-2 sentences the aim of your study.
- **METHODS** : Briefly state the plan and/or methods used, i.e. how you did the study.
- **RESULTS** : Clearly summarize the data, i.e. what you found. Abstracts must be complete and should include results. Abstracts that do not include results ("results will be presented") will be automatically rejected.
- **CONCLUSIONS** : Briefly state the implications of your findings, i.e. what the results mean.

Prof. Julia Brotherton

Professor, Cancer Prevention Policy and Implementation, University of Melbourne. She was a lead investigator in Australian research that showed dramatic decline in genital warts and cervical pre cancer in the post HPV vaccinated cohort and is a member of the WHO's expert advisory group on cervical cancer elimination.

Prof. Suzanne Garland

is a Clinical Microbiologist from Melbourne, Australia and is Internationally renowned for her work in the field of HPV vaccines. She is the current president of the International Papilloma Virus Society (IPVS) and was the inaugural and past president of AOGIN.



Dr. Partha Basu

Head, Screening Group, IARC. He has pioneered work on the single dose HPV vaccine, on the use of thermal ablation to treat cervical pre cancer and the use of artificial intelligence based devices for screening cervical cancer.

Dr. Patti Gravitt

Deputy Director, Center For Global Health, National Cancer Institute, US. She was one of the first to show that HPV self sampling increased screening coverage and has worked extensively on a systems approach to implementation research to help increase women's access to screening services.

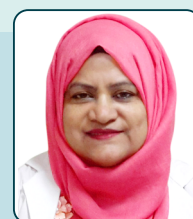


Mr. Janesh Gupta

Prof. of OBGY. University of Birmingham, UK. His areas of special interest are endometrial hyperplasia, endometriosis and laparoscopic surgery. He is the editor-in-chief of the European Journal of Obstetrics and Gynaecology.

Prof. Ashrafunessa

Professor, Dept of Gyn Oncology, Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Medical University, Bangladesh. She initiated the population based breast and cervical cancer screening programme in Bangladesh making it one of the most successful programmes in LMIC. She has worked extensively with IARC to ensure that women in Bangladesh have adequate access to diagnosis and treatment of cervical pre cancer and cancer.

Prof and Program Lead of the MCh Gynecologic Oncology Program, AIIMS, Rishikesh. Academician and a well published clinician with over 150 journal publications and 18 books in gynecology & gynecology. She is the current editor of the Indian Journal of Gynecologic Oncology.
